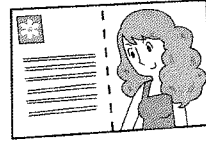

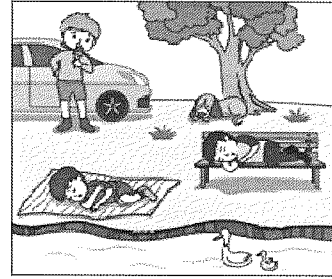



(C) Many people above 65 have problems remembering things. They can't think clearly or take care of themselves well. They might forget their own name, address, or where they put their money. That makes their life so much harder. In fact, they might be sick, and the sickness (25) "dementia." Aging is the main cause of the sickness. The brain cells of these people are damaged little by little, and that makes them unable to think, to talk or to do any daily routines. Sometimes, people with dementia go out and then (26), and that's why they need to carry a note with the address in their pocket. Sometimes, they don't recognize their family; they might think their family are strangers and these strangers will take their money away. Since there is no medicine for the sickness, doctors say we can only train our brain (27). According to a study in the USA in 2014, about 1 billion birds died because they crashed into windows, and the problem will become worse when more and more tall buildings are built.


However, why do birds fly into windows? For birds, the lights in the morning and at night are both dangerous. In the morning, the glass windows may reflect the trees and the skies, so the birds may see windows as the place where they can find food or the place where they can keep flying to. At night, the lights in the offices or in the tall building may draw birds off their flying courses.

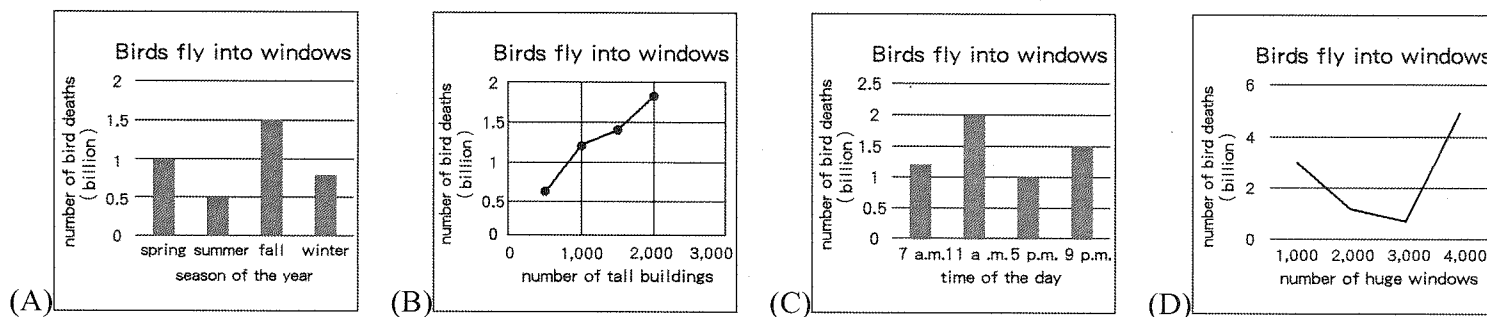

helpful to the birds.

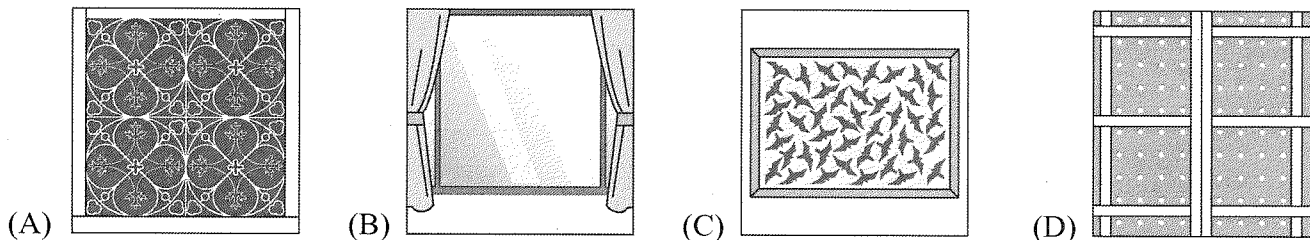
